Health Care for America Now to Show It's a Crime to Deny Care *"Big Insurance: Sick of It" Campaign Escalates in Green Bay as Protesters Head Back to "Scene of the Crime."*

Green Bay: On Wednesday, October 7, the Wisconsin Health Care for America Now Coalition (HCAN)—part of the nation's largest health care campaign—will head back to the "scene of the crime," protesting UnitedHealthcare's putting Wall Street-driven profits before people's health care needs. UnitedHealthcare is the largest health insurance company in the U.S. and Wisconsin.

In Green Bay, the "Big Insurance: Sick of It" push continues as organizers and outraged UnitedHealthcare customers return to the "scene of the crime" armed with signs, personal stories, crime scene tape, and coffins to deliver a simple message: If insurance companies win, we lose.
